Lorraine can even organise a make-up artist to give you a lesson on beauty where you'll learn about different products, or be made over to look like a Gatsby-era belle. This is a great bonding experience for the girls, made especially fun if you don't know your powder from your primer.

Eat: Leura Garage

There's been a bit of a renaissance in Sydney, with old garages transforming themselves into restaurants and bars. Well, the Blue Mountains did it first with Leura Garage, an old auto-repair shop which was converted into a restaurant in 2011. Food and wine are a microcosmic hit list of the area, sourced locally and from the nearby Central Ranges. So you can drink pinot from Orange with beef from Cowra and vegetables roasted with honey from Blackheath. They even make their own pomegranate balsamic and grow herbs in the back garden. Décor is rustic, with cheeky use of the garage theme - tyres stacked on shelves, wrenches embedded into the concrete floors and playful staff in mechanic uniforms (only this time you're not being ripped off). Share plates are encouraged, meaning you can have a fulfilling group dining experience without the inflated bill. Owner James Howarth wants to make you feel like you're at home with a group of friends, and that's exactly the vibe. Now, if only my friends could cook like that...

Chocolate lovers descend upon the cute Leura village for Josophan's Chocolates because it's the cream of the crop when it comes to the sweet stuff. We go 'backstage' into the factory where chasms of silky chocolate await. Everywhere you look there is something to tempt the senses, buckets of ganache, shelves of crisp honeycomb, barrels of hazelnuts, trays of resting caramel, oh my! You'll feel like a kid in a candystore as you learn about these handcrafted sweets. Josophan's have been around since 2005 and continue to win accolades for their unique flavor combinations, including their gold medal winning lime and basil chocolate. It sounds bizarre, but trust us, it works. We tried several times. Just to be certain.

Secret Garden

Visit: Everglades Historic House and Gardens

Remember when you were young and you dreamt of a secret garden with cascading waterfalls, trickling creeks, hedges for hiding in and posies for picking? Well this place exists at Everglades in Lerua. The historic house and garden was built in the 1930s as a weekend retreat for Sydneysiders and, in many ways, it still is. The beautiful gardens are perfect for picnicking and the wonderful volunteers at Everglades will pack you a basket and send you off to explore the grounds. As you wander through the propery, you'll discover wrought iron fences, sandstone arches, Japanese cherry trees, bronze statues and stone fountains. And if the weather isn't the quaintest, the art-deco Everglades House makes a perfect back-up plan for lunch. It's no surprise that Sport for Jove host their annual Shakespeare Festival in these very grounds, because what is a grown-up childhood fantasy if it's not A Midsummer Night's Dream?
