

Fully self-contained, it has three bedrooms but is only let out for one booking per stay - so if there's just two of you, you get the run of the house, which includes kitchen, living area, outdoor barbecue area and more. A lovely touch is the complimentary port, wine, chocolates and breakfast provisions left for guests. The only downside is the 10am checkout. Who wants to leave? 
Spoil yourself with a new level of pampering in Fiji.

FIJI The Shangri-La's Fijian resort has a splendid new addition offering the sort of privacy that the big resorts usually can't provide. Tucked away at the northern end of Yanuca Island, the Chi Spa Village consists of six ocean-front bures with outdoor Jacuzzi, sunken bath, garden and butler service, linked to four tranquil treatment bures – a unique 'spa-within-a-spa'.
