

Project Futures launches “Stella Fella Campaign”

Project Futures, a non-profit organisation that raises awareness and funds to help combat human trafficking and sexual exploitation in Australia and South-East Asia, launched its “Stella Fella” campaign on 1 July.

“All monies raised from the Stella Fella campaign will go towards our partnership with The Salvation Army’s anti-trafficking unit,” said Stephanie Lorenzo, Founder of Project Futures. “We support two of their current projects; the safe house for trafficked victims and the Freedom Advocates Project.”

The safe house provides supported accommodation for both single and young women in Sydney. The women are offered crisis and long-term assistance 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

The Freedom Advocates Project empowers survivors to engage in advocacy activities aimed at ending human trafficking and slavery.
